



HURRICANE POLICY

IN CASE OF A HURRICANE OR OTHER WEATHER RELATED EMERGENCY DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS APPLY:

- ❖ If a hurricane warning is issued and all Palm Beach County Schools are ordered to close, we will also close.
- ❖ If children are at school when a Hurricane Warning is issued, all parents will be contacted immediately and children must be picked up.
- ❖ After a hurricane, Palm Beach County Health Department will not allow us to reopen unless we have power and they have inspected for damages.
- ❖ This means that even if the school suffers NO damages, we will not be allowed to reopen unless power is restored. In the past, we have always opened much quicker than public schools though. Emails will be sent alerting parents as well.
- ❖ Parents should call the school daily to obtain information. Once we have power, we will call every single family to let them know we are open.
- ❖ Signs will also be posted on the outside door to keep parents informed.
- ❖ There will not be refunds or credits of tuition for time school is closed due to Weather related closings, but we do open ASAP.
- ❖ We understand that our families have duties and responsibilities. Depending on the circumstances, we do our best to reopen as quickly as possible.
